Pre-Enrolment Dates & Open House	<ul> <li>Complete Pre-Enrolment Online in SchoolZone between February 1 and March 22, 2024 (by 4:00 p.m.).</li> <li>Our Londonderry School Open House will be held on Tuesday March 5th, 2024, from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. (Doors open at 5:45 p.m)</li> </ul>				
Designated Attendance Area	<ul> <li>Resident students who live within the Londonderry School Attendance Area are guaranteed admission during pre-enrolment.</li> <li>(Go to <a href="https://epsb.ca/schools/findaschool/fast/">https://epsb.ca/schools/findaschool/fast/</a> to find what your designated junior high school is.)</li> <li>Proof of Address is required by providing the following documentation: driver's license, utility bill, home insurance, property tax bill.</li> </ul>				
After Pre-Enrolment - Closed Grades	<ul> <li>It is highly likely that Londonderry School will be full in planned classes in all grades immediately following pre-enrolment on March 22, 2024.</li> <li>Once we are full in planned classes, we cannot accept designated area students who pre-enrolled elsewhere. We can only then accept resident students who have newly moved into the school's attendance area.</li> </ul>				
Academic Enrichment Program	<ul> <li>See the Londonderry School - Academic Enrichment Program 2024-2025 Information document for detailed information about additional pre-enrolment steps required.</li> <li>NOTE: For our alternative Academic Enrichment program classes, we accept students in the following order:         <ul> <li>Resident students who live in Londonderry School's attendance area.</li> <li>Siblings of students currently in an LD AEP class and who will be returning to LD for the 2024-2025 school year.</li> <li>Other resident students.</li> <li>Other non-resident students.</li> </ul> </li> <li>*Difference between Resident and Non-Resident Students: The Division is required by provincial legislation to serve resident students first. A resident student of Edmonton Public Schools typically has at least one parent or legal guardian living in Edmonton who is not Roman Catholic.</li> </ul>
